Philatelic Quiz

Q1: US 1933 NRA Stamp Scott 732; what is the design error?

Q2: After WW II at the countries occupied by the allies', stamps were issued with the "AMG" or special stamps were printed. In which country this did not happen? Why?

Q3: In the XIX Century Argentina had a civil war between the states; what states issued its own stamps? The Argentine Civil Wars were a series of civil wars that took place in Argentina from 1814 to 1880. These conflicts were separate from the Argentine War of Independence (1810–1820), though they first arose during this period.

Q4: By the end of WW II, Yugoslavia was a country created

in Southeastern and Central Europe for most of the 20th century. After an economic and political crisis in the 1980s and the rise of nationalism, Yugoslavia broke up along its republics' borders, at first into five countries, leading to the Yugoslav Wars. What countries were created that issued their own stamps? (5)

Q5: In 1857 the Russian Empire issued its first stamp. In 1917 the Empire disap-

peared. There were many geographical changes. After 1985, Mikhail Gorbachev, the last Soviet premier, sought to reform and liberalize political life and the economy through new policies

of glasnost (openness)

and perestroika (restructuring). These policies caused political instability arising from nationalist and separatist movements. In 1989, Soviet-allied states in Eastern Europe were overthrown in a wave of revolutions which ended communist rule.

Between those dates what countries changed names, were formed, and later changed, that issued their own stamps? There are many.. So check it out. (15)

Q6: During the US Civil war the Confederation issued its own stamps. Between what dates were these stamps valid for postage?

Q7: What Canadian provinces issued their own stamps? (5)

Q8: After WW I how did the Ottoman Empire breakdown? (12)
